

In partial modification of existing norms for assessment of disposal of cases by the District/ Additional District & Sessions Judges, I have been directed to convey that the mandatory condition of disposal of one rent appeal has been relaxed to the extent that where no rent appeal is pending or where no rent appeal is matured for adjudication, one additional civil appeal in lieu thereof will now be required to be disposed of.
