NOTIFICATION

Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice is pleased to make the following amendments in the "High Court of Himachal Pradesh (Use, Maintenance and Control of Staff Cars) Rules, 2014":-

Short title	1.	These Rules shall be called the "High Court of Himachal Pradesh (Use, Maintenance and Control of Staff Cars) (Second Amendment-2017) Rules, 2014.
Commencement	2.	These Rules shall come into force with immediate effect.
Amendment	3	<p>Rule 10(g) of "Judges Relief Vehicle/General Pool Vehicle on payment basis" shall stand deleted and substituted by the following:-</p> <p>"(g)(i) Without prejudice to the official requirements, the Judges' relief vehicle or general pool vehicle, if available, may be used by the Judges or their family members for non-duty purposes in addition to the staff car allotted to the Judge, after prior approval of the Chief Justice, on fuel basis, outside M.C. Limits of Shimla Town, as follows:-</p> <p>High Court Registry will fill up the petrol/diesel, as the case may be, in the Judges Relief Vehicle/ Pooled vehicle before start of journey beyond the MC Limits of shimla town and thereafter, the petrol/diesel during the entire journey is to be purchased by judge and on conclusion of the journey, the tank of Judges Relief vehicle/General Pool Vehicle is to be filled up by the Judge and vehicle is to be handed over to the High Court Registry. Such a vehicle may be permitted to be used for a Maximum of 05 days and in case any dispute arises in this behalf, then the same shall be referred to the Chief Justice and his decision shall be final."</p> <p>10(g)(ii)"Without prejudice to the official requirements, the Judges Relief Vehicle/General Pool vehicle may be used by the Judges for non duty purposes within MC Limits of Shimla town on the rates as may be prescribed for private journey by Government of Himachal Pradesh from time to time. The Controlling Officer will allow the local use of vehicle within M.C.limits of Shimla Town on receipt of reference from the Secretary of the concerned Judge, without seeking further directions from the Chief Justice, subject to availability of vehicle".</p>
